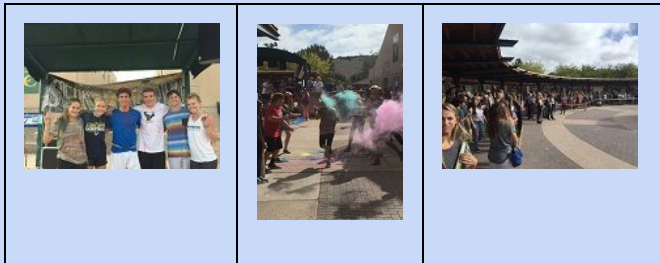

### **College Information/ Letter of Recommendation (LOR)**

For student applying to private 4-year Colleges/ Universities that requires a counselor letter of recommendation, contact your counselor and ask if she can write you a letter of recommendation. Next, provide your counselor with a copy of the FERPA agreement and complete the counselor brag packet in NAVIANCE. Both are under the "About Me" tab on your NAVIANCE Family Connection page. After completing the LOR packet, go to the "Colleges" tab on your NAVIANCE Family Connection Page, click on the "Colleges I'm Applying To" link and scroll to the bottom of the page. Click on "Add Teacher Requests." Select your counselor's name and your counselor will be notified of your request. Email your counselor if you have LOR questions.
